Modes of persuasion. Originating from Aristotle's Rhetoric, the four modes of persuasion in an argument are as follows: . Logos is an appeal to logic using intellectual reasoning and argument structure such as giving claims, sound reasons for them, and supporting evidence.

Ethos – persuasion through the author's character or credibility. This is the way a speaker (or writer) presents herself to the audience. You can build credibility by citing professional sources, using content-specific language, and by showing evidence of your ethical, knowledgeable background. Logos – persuasion through logic.
